LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

Reception: This half term we will be learning all about 'Ourselves'. We will talk about our bodies and how we grow and change.

Year 1: We have been practising forming letters and numbers correctly and reading and writing numbers to 100. We are looking for signs of Autumn, learning about the UK and enjoying lots of outdoor learning in The Grove.

Year 2: In Maths we are focusing on addition and subtraction with number lines. In English we are looking at non fiction texts and writing non chronological reports about animals.

In Geography we are learning about our world. We are naming 7 continents and 5 oceans and locating hot and cold countries. In art we are learning about the artist Kandinsky and painting in his style.
