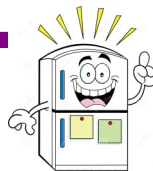

## LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

Reception : We are learning to write sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. In maths we will be using objects to help us add and take away numbers.

Yr 1: We are learning about measuring, shapes and telling the time in maths. In English we are writing non-fiction reports. We are looking at historical artefacts and the way things have changed in the home.

Yr 2: We are learning multiplication and division facts for 2,3,4,5 and 10 times table. We are also learning doubles and halves of numbers to 30 off by heart. In English we are reading and writing poems using adjectives and similes. We are learning about the human body in science and will be learning about different the stages of human life and the different organs inside our body.
