### Harvest Festival

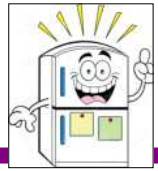

**LEARNING SPOTLIGHT**

Reception : Reception are learning all about ourselves. We will be talking about what makes us special and who is in our family.

Yr 1: This term, Year 1 are learning to write different types of texts in response to reading 'Harry the Happy Mouse'. In maths we are developing our understanding of bigger numbers. We are also learning all about the UK and are exploring our five senses.

Yr 2: In maths we are learning to count on in 10's from any number & learning to add two digit numbers together. In English we are reading the Story 'The Way for Wolf using adjectives to describe the characters from the story. We are also learning about 'The World' in Geography and about animals in Science.
