Friday 2nd December at 9.30 am.



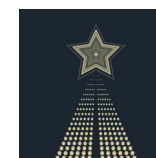
Key Stage One: Years One and Two

Tuesday 6th December at 1.45 pm and

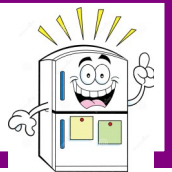
Wednesday 7th December at 9.30am.

LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

Reception are learning all about toys. We will be exploring how they work where they come from and also looking at toys from the past.

Yr 1 are studying non-fiction texts. We are learning about materials and their properties and comparing our lives to those of people in the past.

Yr 2: In Literacy we are looking at winter poetry and writing stories based on 'Winnies Flying Carpet'.
