A belated Happy New Year and a warm welcome to new children and families joining us this term!

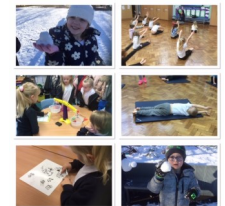
The children have settled back into school well since we returned. They have been doing lots of fun things already this term!

LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

Reception : Our topic is 'food'. We are learning about healthy/unhealthy foods. Using maps, we will look at where different food comes from. We will be celebrating Chinese New Year.

Yr 1: We are reading lots of traditional tales this half term and writing our own versions of stories. We are studying hot and cold places around the world and learning how to be responsible with money.

Yr 2: In English we are reading the book 'Man on the Moon' and completing sentences about it. In History we are learning about the life of famous astronaut Neil Armstrong and in Maths we are learning about ordering numbers to 100. We are looking at different strategies for adding and subtracting.
