# Home Reading Books



- Our reading books are organised in the order that we teach phonics.
- The children will be given two books on their allocated book change day. The books will contain words, letters and sounds they have been taught in their phonics lesson that week. This means they are “phonetically decodable” and the children can practise applying the phonics they have already learnt.

# Reading Record Books

---

- This is your book to write in every time you listen to your child read. **Please listen to your child read every day.**  
They might read a few pages, concentrate on a single page or reread the book again for fluency. Depending on your child, this might take just a few minutes, 5 or 10 minutes or they may be able to focus on their reading a bit longer.
- After they have read each day, please sign and date that you have listened to your child that day. You can also comment what went well, what needs a bit more practise or what you discussed about the story if you wish.
- Please make sure that your child brings thier school bag with your reading record book and reading book everyday as children may also be reading to adults in class throughout the week.
