

LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

Reception: In reception we are learning to write a simple sentence with a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop. Our topic this half term is animals.

Yr 1: In English we are studying the fantasy story "Where The Wild Things Are" by Maurice Sendak and will be creating our own fantasy stories and maps of fantasy worlds. We are also learning how to describe and sort animals and will be completing some orienteering and map work.

Yr 2: In English we are reading 'The Highway Rat' by Julia Donaldson and writing character profiles. We are also writing a non fiction text about rats. In Science we are learning about minibeast habitats and food chains. In Geography we are comparing Burnley with Bondi in Australia and looking at human and physical geographical features. We are continuing our link with the year 2's from Barden and will be welcoming them to Rosegrove and visiting their school.
