Arriving in the morning

Both Yr 2 & Yr 1 children and families to line up on the playground on arrival, please.

Yr 2 Emerald; against the front wall (by the clock) at 8.40 a.m. promptly

Yr 2 Opal; along the picket fence (by the Grove) at 8.40 a.m. promptly

Yr 1 Sapphire; against the front wall (by the clock) at 8.50 a.m. promptly

Yr 1 Diamond; along the picket fence (by the Grove) at 8.50 a.m. promptly

Reception families, if you could please wait by the railings (inside the school grounds is safer) until the Yr 1 families have gone, and then come fully onto the yard to wait for the Reception Garden Gate to open at 8.55 a.m.

At the end of the day all year groups (inc Reception) to line up again, please.

As we have mentioned in previous letters/newsletters & Welcome Meetings, to help with parking we ask that whenever possible, you do not arrive too early at drop off and pick up times and leave promptly once you have picked your child up.

(Also, we ask that children DO NOT play or run around the playground due to Health and Safety , They should stay with parents/carers in the line every morning. The children know this. Please encourage them to stay with you as you arrive and line up).

PUPILS' BRANCHES OF RESPONSIBILITY



At Rosegrove Infant School our pupils will learn to: ...



- Get up straight away each morning when parents/carers wake them.
- Get themselves dressed in the correct uniform, in time for school.
- Bring their own school bag and coat every day.
- Greet the grown-ups politely and walk into school independently.
- Check through their red, school bags in class every morning and hand money envelopes and letters to their teacher.
- Look after their own belongings in school.
- Remember that trusted grown-ups are in charge, at home and in school.
- Tell the teacher if something upsets them in school and trust the adults to sort and deal with worries.
- Tell their family about their school day.
- Remember to pass on messages to their family.
- Remind grown-ups at home, to check through their school bag each day.
