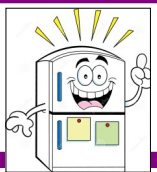
September 2024

LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

Reception : This half term, we will be learning about 'Toys'. We will look at old toys and new toys and compare them. We will investigate how different toys work.
