We are raising money for school books! We have purchased lots of new sets recently, but are desperate for more in some of the levels. The cost of a set is so expensive.



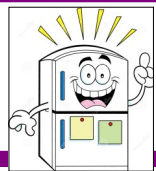
Can you help?

LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

Reception : This half term our topic is 'Food'. We will be sorting healthy/unhealthy foods and looking at foods from around the world.

Yr 1: This term year one are reading lots of traditional tales and learning to count in steps of 2, 5 and 10. We are comparing hot and cold places and learning about where money comes from.

Yr 2: In Year 2 we are learning about Neil Armstrong and the events in his life. In English we are reading the book 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram and looking at the character Bob and his job as an astronaut. In Science we are learning about Materials and their properties.
