#### Allergies

Due to children having **nut allergies** in school, we ask that you do not send any nuts in your child's packed lunch.

#### Morning drop off

We ask that when dropping your child off at school they stay with you in the line. This is to keep them safe as we have no adults in the yard to supervise.

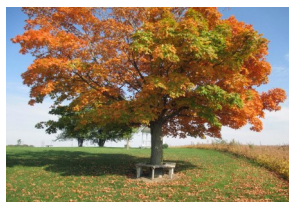
#### Uniform/Earrings

Can you please put your child's name in all their uniform including PE uniform. **CHILDREN MUST NOT WEAR EARRINGS IN SCHOOL.** We recommend you get your child's ears pierced in the summer holidays. This is a Governor Policy to support Health and Safety in School. We also ask that you send your child to school with a coat every day— the British weather is so unpredictable!
