- We have got a busy half term ahead, please look out for text messages. If you change your mobile number please speak to the school office.



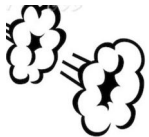
Safety first

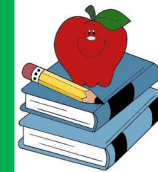
